St Joseph's School, Ordsall – Polytunnel

Awarded a grant of £2,000 for the purchase of a polytunnel as part of the school's Grow 2 Grow gardening project.

Hallcroft Nursery and Infant School, Retford – Community Daily Mile project

Awarded a grant of £2,000 towards the installation of a running/walking track at the school for daily community use.

Everton Primary School – 'Hub and Tubs' shelter and planting area

£2,000 was awarded towards a gardening project and construction of a shelter for the school and wider community use.

Connexions Community Hub, Gainsborough – equipment for community hub

Awarded £1,500 towards the purchase of a cooker and set-up a community kitchen to teach cookery skills and how to prepare healthy meals.

Bawtry Residents Group – equipment for junior football team

Awarded a grant of £1,500 towards the cost of goal and corner posts, line-painting equipment and football kit for young footballers.

LIVES – life-saving equipment

An award of £3,500 was made towards the cost of equipping a new medic for the LIVES Lincs Emergency Responders group.

Austerfield Parish Council – outdoor sports equipment

Awarded £1,200 for the purchase of an outdoor fitness station as part of an extension of the village's recreational facilities.

Owby and Normanby Community Park Committee – new children's play area

An award of £2,000 was made towards the creation of new play facilities for the children of both villages.

Barnby Memorial Hall – improvements to disabled facilities

£2,000 was awarded towards the cost of installing a lift to the upper floor and other improvements for disabled visitors to the hall.

Barnby Moor Parish Council - Kitchen improvements

An award of £3,000 was made for improvements to the Barnby Moor village hall as part of a refurbishment programme.

Torworth Playing Field Committee – swing set

£1,500 was awarded towards play equipment for older children in the village.

Torworth Parish Council – defibrillator

£1,500 was awarded for the purchase and installation of a defibrillator in Torworth.

Gringley Parish Council – defibrillator

An award of £1,000 was made to purchase a defibrillator to be installed in the village of Gringley-on-the-Hill.

Fillingham Parish Meeting – improvements to community facilities

£2,500 was awarded towards improvements to the village hall and green.

Barton Stacey Parish Council – sports equipment

An award of £3,500 was made to purchase sports equipment for a fit and fun project in the village.

Challengers – play equipment for disabled youngsters

A grant of £1,300 was awarded to purchase play equipment for disabled young people at two Challengers centres – Holybourne and Godstone.

Singleton Village Hall – kitchen improvements

£4,000 was awarded towards the cost of redecorating and upgrading the kitchen in the village hall.

West Clandon Parish Council – car park extension

An award of £2,000 was made towards the cost of extending the car park at the village recreation ground which also serves the village hall.

Clatfords Village Store – outdoor seating

£1,500 was awarded towards the cost of installing seating in a shelter to be constructed beside the village community shop.

Shalford Football Club – barrier replacement

A grant of £750 was awarded to purchase a new barrier for the football club's ground.

Auntie Val's Ability Centre – lidding machinery

£2,500 was awarded towards the cost of a lidding machine to assist disabled workers in the centre's production of jams and chutneys.

Treloar's School – disabled play equipment

A grant of £400 was awarded to purchase a piece of play equipment for a new sensory play area at the school.

Westminster Families Community Group – Bringing Rossmore and Westminster Together project

Awarded a grant of £1,500 towards equipment for sessions to help with social isolation in the over 50's and to provide support for families and adults with additional needs.

Crafty Beez – Green Beez Family Food and Waste Education project

Awarded a grant of £1,500 for the Green Beez project which aims to teach children and their parents to be more considerate of the environment through practical, fun sessions based on recycling waste food and plastics, reducing carbon footprint, getting creative with nature and learning how to grow and prepare fruit and vegetables for a healthy diet.

Radiate Arts CIC - Feel Great....Create! project

£800 was awarded for the Feel Great ...Create! project – a series of creative workshops for people in Ellesmere Port experiencing varying stages of dementia or with physical disabilities. Local primary school students will become “art buddies” with the participants with each pairing creating a digital work of art using the iPad, bridging the generation gap and learning modern technology in the process.
